■ More than 100 years old, Dick's Castle commands one of Garrison's most breathtaking Hudson Highland views. The current owner commissioned Museum of Modern Art store designer Juer-gen Riehm to create six luxurious "townhouses" in the castle's 40,000 square-foot shell. Two unique and wonderfully appointed homes are featured. ■ A converted shingle-style barn set in a lovely perennial garden courtyard and bordered by an arts and crafts archway features iconic modern furnishings by Le Corbusier, Frank Lloyd Wright, Eileen Gray, Mies Van Der Rohe and Massimo Vignelli. ■ Originally built in 1895 by New York Central Railroad President Samuel Sloan as a wedding present for his daughter, an updated Queen Anne Victorian preserves many interior details giving an authentic sense of late 19th-century style with modern flair. ■ Reflecting the owners' travels and love of Italian design, a home designed by Honolulu, Hawaii-based architect Jim Schmit creates a perfect setting for large scale sculptures and art and collectibles from 18th century Asia and 19th and 20th century artists. ■ A unique blend of Classical and Vernacular traditions built on a knoll adjoining historic Castle Rock by architect Michael Bialecki features a design plan recalling the owner's Greek Revival family mansion in the Louisiana low country while its asymmetry and board & batten detailing evoke A.J. Downing's Hudson River Stick style.

You will drive your own car to each home where you will be welcomed to visit at your own pace. Enjoy lunch outdoors at a garden or terrace of one of the homes on the tour.
